



Directions to Staines Salvation Army Hall & Resource Centre

Woodthorpe Road, Ashford, Middlesex, TW15 3JY

By train from London Waterloo

Trains to Ashford (Middlesex) take 35 to 45 minutes from London Waterloo, towards Windsor & Eton.

From Ashford station walk out along Station Approach and right onto Woodthorpe Road. The hall is about a mile away on the left.

By bus

Busses that stop nearby are the 117 (Staines, Ashford, Feltham, Hounslow, Isleworth) and 216 (Kingston, Hampton, Sunbury, Ashford), the 555, 556 and 557.

From the M25

Exit at Junction 13 onto A30 for Staines/London.

At the Crooked Billet roundabout continue on A30 to Ashford/Heathrow.

At the traffic lights by Ashford Hospital turn right into Stanwell Road.

Take the fourth right onto Stanwell Road.

Over the bridge turn right onto Woodthorpe Road at the first mini roundabout and straight over the second which follows immediately.

The hall is about 200 yards on the left.

From the M3

Exit at Junction 1, Sunbury Cross, onto the A308 towards Staines and continue along dual carriageway through several sets of lights. Turn right at roundabout (3rd exit) onto Fordbridge Road and left at a mini roundabout onto Stanwell Road. At the bottom of the road turn left at the mini roundabout onto Woodthorpe Road.

The hall is about 200 yards on the left

From London on the A30

Remain on the A30 past Heathrow airport and Hatton Cross tube station.

Follow the dual carriageway A30 until the junction, with Ashford Hospital (on right) where you turn left into Stanwell Road.

Take the fourth right onto Stanwell Road.

Over the bridge turn right onto Woodthorpe Road. Go straight over the two mini roundabouts and the hall is about 200 yards on the left.
